Section 1<sup>st</sup> That the name of the Town of Winnebago in the County of Winnebago is hereby changed and shall hereafter be called and known in law and otherwise by the name of Oshkosh -

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Winnebago do Order and determine as follows -

Section 1<sup>st</sup> That Township nineteen north of Range fourteen East shall constitute a town and shall be organized and known by the name of

Poy-gon. And that the first annual town meeting in said town shall be held at the house of Jonathan Mason -
