AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TERRITORY TO THE VILLAGE OF KEWASKUM

The Village Board of the Village of Kewaskum, Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Territory Annexed. In accordance with s. 66.025 of the Wisconsin Statutes of 1957, all of the land in the territory hereinafter described in the Town of Auburn, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin, and now owned by the Village of Kewaskum, Washington County, Wisconsin, is annexed to the Village of Kewaskum, Wisconsin:

All that part of the Southwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$), Section Thirty-one (31), Township Thirteen (13) North, Range Nineteen (19) East, Town of Auburn, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. Effect of Annexation. From and after the date of this ordinance the territory described in section 1 shall be a part of the Village of Kewaskum for any and all purposes provided by law and all persons coming or residing within such territory shall be subject to all ordinances, rules and regulations governing the village of Kewaskum.

SECTION 3. Severability. If any provision of this ordinance is invalid or unconstitutional, or if the application of this ordinance to any person or circumstances is invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions or applications of this ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

SECTION 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by law.

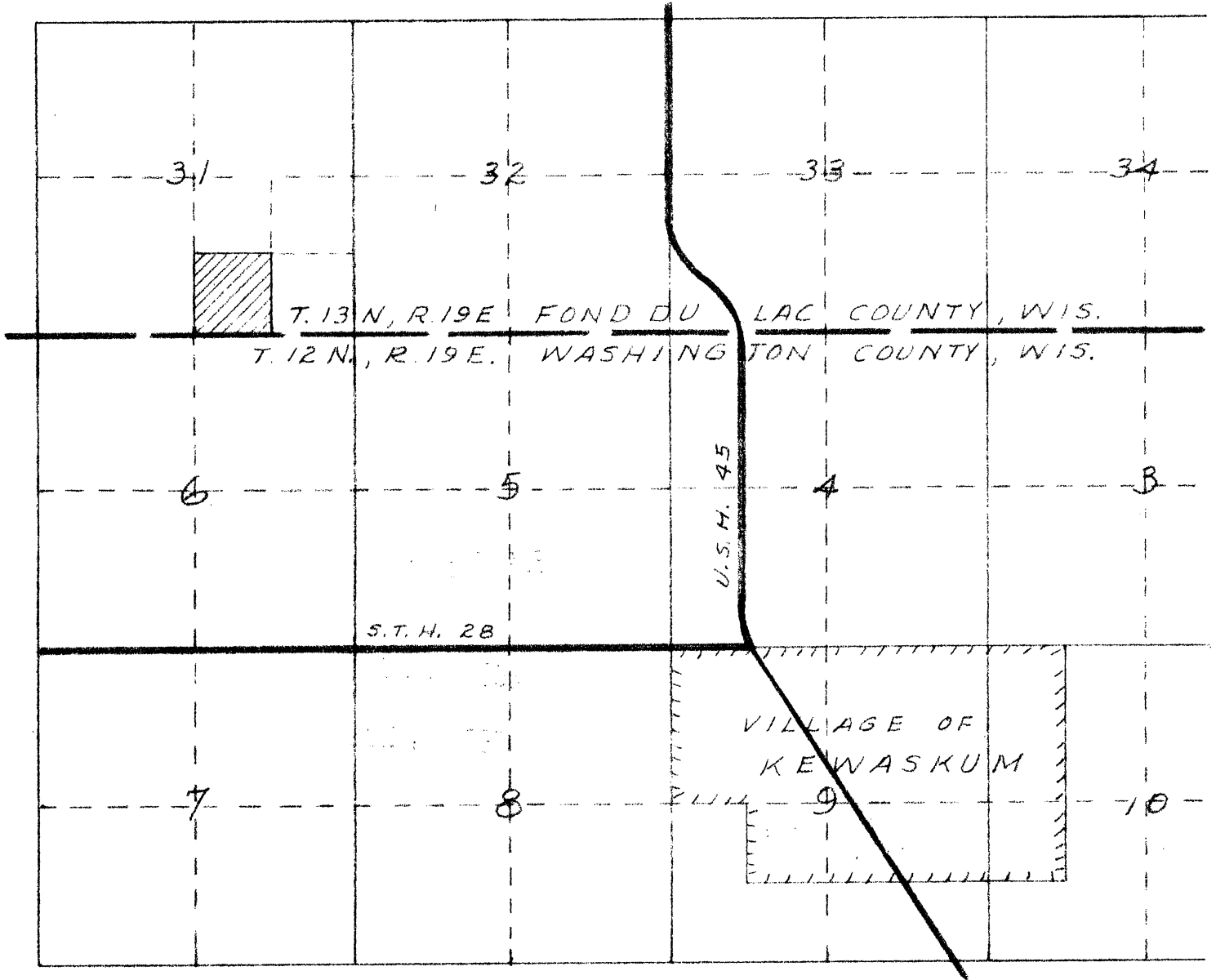
